Now imagine trying to celebrate the holidays with little to no income. Imagine parents wanting to gift their children something but cannot afford to do so.

The Adopt-a-Family program here at BB4Kids was created six years ago to give the kids a Christmas full of joy and to lessen the financial burden put on these already struggling parents during the holidays. This is where sponsors come in.

For his mother, it was heart-warming to have the camp counselors provide encouragement and the opportunity given to Donny to interact with other campers. Whenever someone fell off the paddleboard, they would encourage one another to get back on” mom recalled. When it was over Donnie mentioned that he was disappointed that it had



to end.

Overall, Donnie had an amazing time in a place that allowed him to meet people, experience outstanding activities, and foster social interaction. This event made a huge impression on him. He still talks about it to this day.

Donnie is just one example of BB4Kids' mission to help children reach their full potential.

It is our desire to help children have these experiences so they can build self-esteem and confidence while learning skills that will allow them to be a vital part of their communities.
